The CoP is the project's primary coordination and support mechanism.

Objectives

- Connect NAs and RFOs
- Support peer learning and mutual exchange
- Identify implementation challenges and promising practices
- Inform capability building, monitoring and tool development
- Strengthen policy coordination across the ERA

Structure

- National Authorities Circle
- Research and Innovation Funding Organisations Circle
- Joint cross-circle exchanges and mutual learning workshops

NATIONAL AUTHORITIES CIRCLE

Representatives of NAs responsible for gender equality and inclusiveness in research and innovation and ERA-related coordination.

Working modalities

- Meetings every 6–8 weeks
- Bi-monthly online and in-person meetings
- Structured format (scan of national developments, thematic inputs, guided peer exchange, reflection rounds, and action-planning)
- Optional 1:1 support sessions
- Learning-loop model

Representatives of RFOs

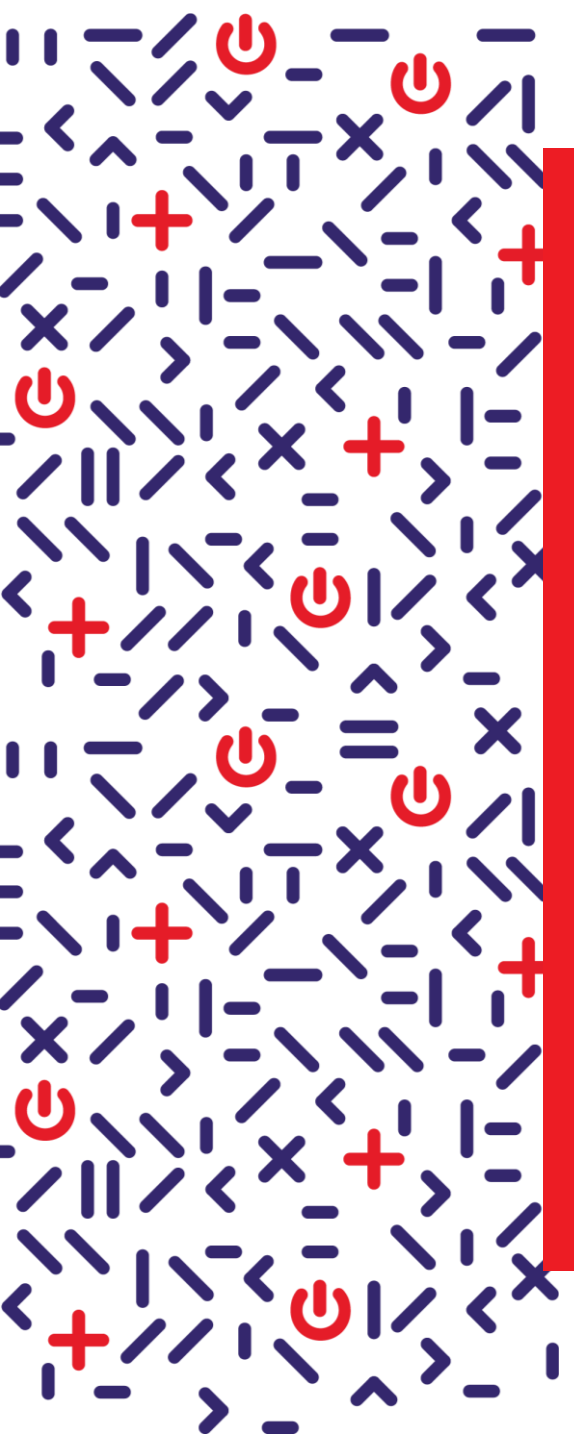
Working modalities

- Bifocal mentoring model
- 3–5 thematic mentoring teams
- RFO mentors and mentees
- 12-month mentoring cycles
- Flexible reallocation between teams
- Joint mutual learning workshops
- Cross-circle exchanges with National Authorities

IMPACT

1. Stronger institutional capabilities within NAs and RFOs to design, implement and monitor inclusive GE policies.
2. More consistent and targeted policy instruments supporting inclusive gender equality, intersectionality and gender mainstreaming.
3. Improved evidence, transparency and accountability for policy implementation.
4. More enabling conditions for diverse groups of researchers and innovators.
5. Greater resilience of GE implementation under uneven capabilities and political contexts.
